## Waste

- Waste will be sorted – paper, plastic, metals, glass for recycling.
- Spent coffee ground used to produce biochar for research purposes.
- Residual gastro-waste and used biodegradable dishes energetically valorised.

- Bags made of recycled plastic or organic cotton.
